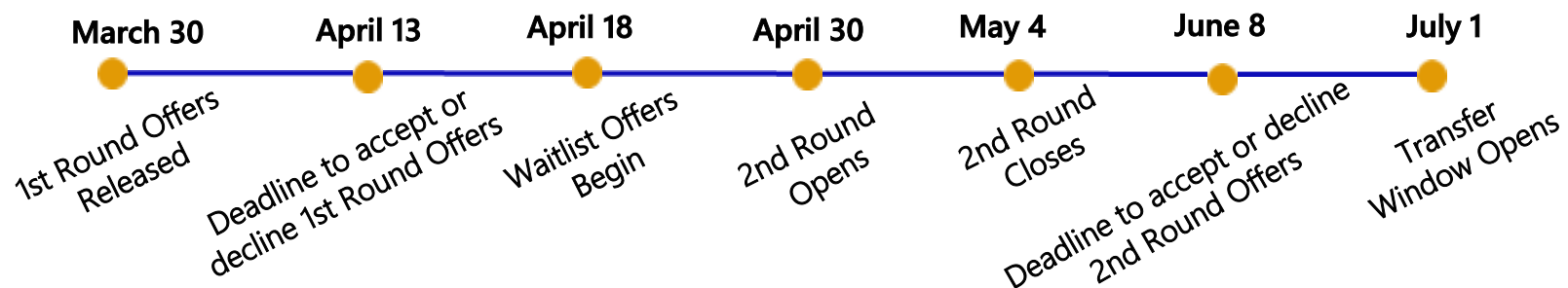


USE **GoCPS** TO **BE NOBLE**

GoCPS Timeline and Frequently Asked Questions



First-Round Notifications

Q: *How will my student be notified of their offer?*

A: Notification letters will be mailed to the home address listed on the application. Students can also view their offer using their GoCPS account.

Q: *How many offers can my student receive in the first-round?*

A: Eligible students can receive a maximum of one Non-Selective Enrollment offer and one Selective-Enrollment offer. Students are also guaranteed a seat at their designated neighborhood high school. Gary Comer Middle School students are also guaranteed a seat at their "continuing" school Gary Comer College Prep High School.

Accepting and Declining Offers

Q: *How does my student accept or decline their first-round offer?*

A: Offers can be accepted or declined via the student's online GoCPS account by April 13. Paper applicants can accept or decline their offers by submitting the paper confirmation form mailed by CPS or by using the online GoCPS account created by CPS. Details on how to access this account can be found in the students offer letter.

Q: *What is the next step after accepting my offer?*

A: Once a student has accepted their offer, they will be contacted by the Noble campus with next steps. Two proofs of address will be requested upon registration.

Q: *Can I change my student's accepted or declined offer?*

A: Declined offers cannot be reversed. Students will have the option to decline an accepted offer at a later time.

Waitlists

Q: *Why has my student been waitlisted?*

A: If a campus has more applicants than seats available, a random lottery of all applicants occurs. Students who do not receive a seat in the lottery are placed on a waiting list.

Q: *How do I accept or decline a waitlist offer?*

A: Waitlist offers can be accepted or declined via the GoCPS account within 48 business hours after the offer is made. Paper applicants can accept or decline offers by calling 833-BeNoble (833-236-6253) or by using the online GoCPS account created by CPS.

Q: *What happens to my first-round offer if I accept a waitlist offer?*

A: Accepting a waitlist offer automatically declines the first-round offer.

Q: *How long am I allowed to stay on the waitlist?*

A: After Noble Lock Day (July 1), students are only allowed to remain on Noble waiting lists if they have not accepted a seat at another Noble campus for the remainder of the current school year.

Second-Round Notifications

Q: *What happens to my first-round offer if I participate in the second-round?*

A: If a student participates in the second-round, they risk losing their first-round offer even if they do not accept a second-round offer. If a student receives an offer in the second-round, the first-round offer is automatically forfeited. You will not lose your first-round offer if you do not receive a second-round offer.

Q: *Will all Noble campuses participate in the second-round?*

A: Only Noble campuses that have seats available will participate in the second-round.

Q: *Does applying in the second-round impact my student's waitlist position?*

A: Students participating in the second-round are allowed to stay on the waitlist. After July 1 students are only allowed to stay on Noble waitlists if they have not accepted a seat at another Noble campus.

Q: *Are counselors allowed to accept or decline offers on behalf of my student?*

A: Eighth grade counselors are allowed to accept or decline offers on behalf of students if a second proxy form was filled out and signed. The second proxy form was distributed to eighth grade counselors and school staff in March.

School Year 2018-2019 Transfers

Q: *How can I find out which Noble campuses have available seats?*

A: Please visit noblenetwork.org/enroll or contact our Enrollment Office at 833-BeNoble (833-236-6253) for a list of Noble campuses that will have seats available for fall. Additionally a list of Noble campuses with available seats will be posted July 1 on the GoCPS website.
